Assini Acropolis

Closest archeological site, the ancient kingdom of Assini, is only 10 minutes away.

Assini acropolis is located on top of the hill between Plaka beach and Kokkinos vrahos beach. It was first inhabited 7000 years ago and has been well described as early as in Homer's Iliad and Odyssey as one of the Greek kingdoms participating in a ten years old devastating Trojan war. The archeological place has been first scientifically excavated by Swedish Archaeological Expedition in 1922 and many of Greek artefacts are still on display in Sweden.

The site is publicly open without admission fee. Apart from antique monuments it includes also 2nd World War exposition. Besides these it offers a spectacular view on Tolo and Plaka.

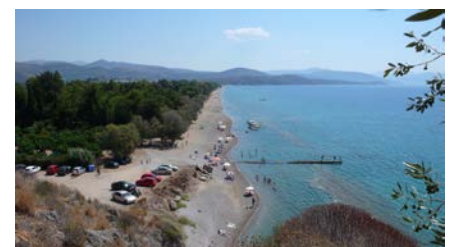
